Milestone 2: Specifying Your Data Sources and Data Classes

For this milestone you will define key characteristics of the data that is used and created by your app. Your second milestone is to submit a table describing your app's data types, the purpose of each data type (from the app or user's perspective), data sources, and data storage locations. This is due Monday, October 9, 2023, by 11:59pm. Your designs should align with the General Requirements outlined in the project rubric. For instance, your app must store and retrieve at least some of its data to/from a remote storage site.

Your table should include at least the four columns described above for each key data type. Include as much detail as necessary to cover the major functionalities you envision your app having. This will help you refine your ideas and ensure that your project stays on track.

Please compile your rough sketches into a single PDF file named "Milestone_2.pdf" and upload it to your GitLab repository. We've added a Project folder with a README in the upstream repository to assist you in organizing your work.
